The Camper in Leadership Training (CILT) program

The Camper in Leadership Training (CILT) program is a volunteer program for students entering the 10th through 12th grades. The goal of the program is to provide qualified young people with leadership experiences that are designed to prepare you to be future camp counselors and leaders.

By direct participation in a camp setting, you will have the opportunity to learn through observation, discussion and interaction with children, parents and staff.



Prepare for your future!

As a CILT, you will gain valuable experience working with children. Many of our CILTs have gone on to become staff, and many of our staff have gone on to work in careers with children; in education, healthcare and other fields. They often tell us that our programs gave them some of the best preparation for their current work.



How will I know what to do?

CILTs attend two Saturday training sessions before camp begins, and must commit to being available for the whole 9 week camp season (some partial summer positions are available). CILTs are at camp Monday through Friday, on the bus at approximately 8:30 a.m. and back home by 4:30 p.m.

Activities ...

You'll participate in activities like: Swimming, Horseback Riding, Ropes Courses, Arts & Crafts, Hiking, Archery, Fishing, Canoeing, Gymnastics, Nature & Ecology, Rock Climbing, Team Sports, and much more. In addition to the memories you'll create, your time at camp this summer can count toward volunteer hours necessary for CSF and college applications. Paid senior staff positions are also available for graduating seniors.



Do I stay with the same group all summer?

Each CILT gains experience with up to four different groups throughout the summer. The goal is to have you interact with a variety of different age groups; this allows you to be exposed to children at different developmental levels and to learn about the varying needs of campers. During each assignment, you will grow in leadership ability and will be able to assume more and more responsibility in the group.

Through frequent meetings with your Leadership Advisor, CILTs discuss observations, share successes and ask questions. The meetings provide a meaningful base for understanding the nature of camp counseling.

The CILT program provides an opportunity to gain valuable leadership experience through teaching, playing with and learning from children. CILTs are involved in a training program that includes working hand in hand with staff, being evaluated by staff members and receiving feedback from the directors.

Each CILT has the opportunity to work with different camp groups throughout the summer. This allows the CILT to observe and participate in many different styles of group leadership and provides the opportunity to learn about children of different ages. This exposure to children at different developmental levels is critical in providing a well-rounded training program. As the summer progresses, CILTs refine their skills and develop their own styles for working with children.

Sunny Skies Day Camp is a wonderful place to spend your summer. Being outdoors in a beautiful environment, enjoying old friendships or making new ones, as well as learning and using leadership skills are just a few reasons to be a CILT this summer. If you are someone who is interested in working with children, we encourage you to apply!

The CILT program is a volunteer program for individuals entering the 10th, 11th and 12th grades. All applicants must complete an application and participate in an individual interview. The CILTs are our oldest campers in camp. The registration fee for the entire summer is \$50.00. Daily transportation is provided from our designated bus meeting points. There are a limited number of participants accepted into the program. At the end of the summer, an honorarium is awarded to all CILTs who have successfully completed the CILT program.
